# Cultivation information

## SENETTI® PERICALLIS HYBRIDS



### Flowering characteristics

Senetti® will flower roughly 3 months after potting and is then ready for delivery. Senetti® does not need a cold treatment to induce flowering.

### Cuttings

Start with certified clean cuttings from an official Moerheim New Plant supplier.

### Potting compost

Use a good-quality potting compost with a pH between 5.0 and 6.0.

### Potting

Use a minimum pot size of 12 cm and a maximum pot size of 20 cm. Smaller pot sizes are not recommended for Senetti®.

### Climate

- **Temperature:** after potting, keep the temperature high at around 18°C. Maintain this temperature for a few weeks to allow the plant to become established. After that the growing temperature can be lowered to 5-10°C. Senetti® does not need a cold period to induce flowering. In general, crops grown in cooler conditions are of better quality and produce better flowers.
- **Air humidity (RH):** make sure to avoid excessive humidity, particularly in winter when temperatures are lower.
- **Light:** Senetti® likes light, so it is not suited for very early potting dates (e.g. September to October). 1 December is recommended as the earliest potting date, but a date in January or February is even better.

### Watering

If there is sun in the spring, Senetti® can use a lot of water. However, make sure not to over-water during cultivation as the plants will grow too vigorously. Avoid over-watering at the start of cultivation and during potting, in order to prevent root rot.

### Feeding

Senetti® needs minimal to moderate feeding. Use an EC of 0.5-1 mS (0.5-1 g/l) of a well-balanced mixture that contains all necessary nutrients. If plants are over-fed, the leaves can grow too large. This is mainly due to nitrogen. Make sure plants receive sufficient magnesium.

### Keeping the plants compact

To avoid elongation of the stems and flower stems, use Alar 65% (3 g/l). Regulate growth more often if necessary. When flowering starts, watch out for excessive stretching of the flower stems. Flower damage due to Alar is not especially visible but, as a precaution, its use is better avoided in the later stages. Use negative DIF if necessary. Do not use Cycocel because it can easily cause yellow leaf edges.

### Crop protection

- Senetti® is not particularly susceptible to disease.
- Powdery mildew can occur.

### Growing schedule

	15-20 cm pots:
<b>Potting:</b>	(December), January, February (note: no sooner due to lack of light).
<b>Pinching:</b>	Around 2 weeks after potting when the plant is ready (note: not too early).
<b>Cultivation period:</b>	3 months, depending on planting time, pot size, temperature and variety.
<b>Spacing:</b>	Depends on pot size. Do not over-crowd pots, to avoid yellow leaves at a later stage. This also helps to produce strong, healthy plants.

If you need specific cultivation information about a certain variety in particular, feel free to contact Moerheim New Plant bv.

- Root rot can occur. To avoid this, ensure sufficient evaporation during dull weather and just after potting. Do not allow the crop and compost to become too wet.
- Avoid Botrytis by maintaining an active and sufficiently dry climate.
- Look out for insect pests, especially thrips at the flowering and budding stage. Also watch out for whitefly, aphids, leaf miner and caterpillar. Admire, Mesuro and Vertimec are used to control these pests.

### Transport

Nothing specific, avoid long transports.
